**This award will be made to an outstanding community group that has adopted sound land management practices on public and private land and is working towards sustainable land use and/or enhancing or protecting an area on behalf of the community.**

## **Judging Criteria:**

1. uses comprehensive plans e.g. property and/or catchment plans as a basis for your group activities. Provide a copy of your plans. These may show physical, strategic, management and other attributes of your group's work.
2. has repaired degraded land/environments or prevented degradation and/or developed some on/farm and/or community benefit from your group's activity.
3. has sought advice and worked with others, including the community, other landcare/environment/community groups, government, business and schools to develop your group, your plans and your actions.
4. has shared results to encourage others to be involved in landcare practices, shared landcare skills, practices/outcomes, plans and ideas with your wider community (others not included in your group) e.g. through field days or education campaigns.

## **Ideas for each point:**

1. Landholders: TCWMB/AMLRNRMB (regional geomorphologic mapping, Partalunga (industry corporation large scale ogw), Cromer Conservation Park (public biodiversity focus), Gladigau (primary producer focus) (before and after photos and maps).
2. Prevent further degradation: Noske (riparian), CCP (gorse control), Pindone rabbit control, LCG group meetings CFS, Rathjen (salinity) (before and after photos).
3. Stakeholders: URTLG, MPNRC, Local Govt, MPPS, BHS & BPS, Suppliers and contractors, AMLRNRM Board and its predecessors,
4. Shared results: Media releases, bus tour to Vic, Land Management Course, Prograze, Supplementary feeding Workshops, Field days & bus tours, gate signs and participation in community consultation (media articles, adverts, fact sheets).
